Bye-Law E Referenda

E. Referenda

- 1. A Referendum may be called on any issue by:
 - 1.1. a resolution of the Trustees;
 - 1.2. The Union President,
 - 1.3. a vote of the Union Council; or
 - 1.4. a petition signed by at least 10% of Members
- 2. A resolution may only be passed by Referendum if at least 10% of Members cast a vote in the Referendum and a majority of the votes cast are in favour of the resolution.
- 3. Referenda shall be conducted in accordance with the Constitution and the Bye-Laws.
- 4. Subject to Clause 34 of Bye-Law B, the Members may set Policy by Referenda. Policy set by Referenda will overturn Policy set either by the Members in general meeting or by the Union Council.
