

The Social Enterprise Fund is awarded on a termly basis to students who are developing social enterprises during their time at Imperial. Students can apply for up to £300 per funding round. The award should only be used for the direct benefit and development of the enterprise.

Do's ✓

- Printing of promotional material for networking events e.g. business cards
- Software licenses
- Patent application costs
- Costs towards prototyping e.g. purchase of materials
- Product development
- Marketing / branding materials
- Travel expenses for travel within London Zones 1 – 6
- Market research

Don'ts ✗

- Travel expenses for travel outside of London Zones 1 – 6 **without first consulting with the Student Development Coordinator**
- Expenditure on items unrelated to your social enterprise
- Banned, restricted goods or those prohibited by law
