Nice Weather Ale	Copper coloured fruity Summer ale packed full of flavour. Sweet, malty with a touch of fruits, crisp dry finish.	Dancing Duck, Derbyshire	Blackberry, strawberry and floral rose notes in perfect balance with just the right amount of malt character.	£3.10
Cyborg Ale	Black bodied with a roasted and chocolatey taste.	Black Hole, Burton-on-Trent	A rich golden ale, with a combination of goldings and pilgrim hops that provide a citrus aroma, with a bitter taste.	£3.10
Sea Dog Ale	A strong citrus, bitter, lingering taste with hoppy notes. A golden and fruity ale.	Arundle, West Sussex	A hoppy, golden beer with a citrus character. There are hints of grapfruit and lemon and the bitterness in the taste increases to a slightly dry, hoppy finish.	£3.10
Hapi Ale Ale	A pale ale with roasted malts, caramel and mollasses to create a bitter finish.	Maxim, Tyne and Wear	This pale ale is brewed using Pacifica & Waimea hops from New Zealand. Hints of orange marmalade and fresh tangerine aromas.	£3.10
Twilight Ale	Dark and full bodied.	Lytham, Lancashire	Based on an English mild using only the finest English hops and malts.	£3.10
Manannan's Cloak Ale	Amber appearance with a slightly fruity smell. A subtle, bitter and spicy taste.	Bushy Brewery of Braddan, Isle of Man	A creamy headed, smooth amber ale. A good all round session beer. A subtle bitterness from Manx grown hops give a clean taste and aroma, with a slight fruit/spice after taste.	\$3.10
Portobello Westway Ale	Complex late hop additions give a citrus fruit finishing together with a smooth refreshing palate.
