Yes, once again the RCC has run out of contingency money- apparently this is historically reoccurring, but not frequent enough for it to be worth us asking for more. Last week (on the 4th of June) the RCC approved contingency claims to the value of:

£536.74 (Repair of the Snooker Room on the 3rd floor of the Union due to the Union's poor provision of security)

£150 (For RCS Motor due to being forced to move garage).

We have £246.10 left in the RCC contingency fund.

This leaves a deficit of £440.64

Can we have an extra £440.64 please?

I would argue that this has been a year of particularly expensive contingency claimswe have had 2 in particular from Canoe club and Dance Company which together made £735, and have averted another expensive one by successfully getting Sport Imperial to pay for the repairs of the Snooker room when it was ruined by vandals.
