



1. Change text size, text only, mobile only versions of the site and the sitemap buttons. The mobile version of the site will be optimised for the increased browsing capabilities of modern phones.

2. The login box. When the user clicks on the login box an overlay will appear allowing them to enter their College username and password. This overlay will also contain clear steps for new users to join the site and alumni to use their CID and Date of Birth in order to login. Once the user is logged in the button will disappear and be replaced with the user's account information, Clubs & Societies and also their current basket buttons; again all linking to overlays with further information.

3. Example of a larger sized banner. These newer sizes are becoming more common on websites and advertisers are actively requesting this larger size. We would still be able to use the smaller, traditional size, banners.

4. New streamlined main navigation takes up less space as well as not confusing the user with too many options. Currently this mock-up includes the "New Student" section which will be removed. Also the Democracy section may be renamed the "Representation" sections. We welcome comments on these headings.

5. A marquee banner containing upto 5 images with or without CSS caption. The main banner on the current website has proved to be a massive success. However we can only have one up at-a-time. This widget will enable us to select a JPEG with a CSS caption or a flash file for upto 5 slides. These slides will fade through on to the next one every 7 seconds. We can specify fewer than 5 slides. If you want to skip to another slide you can click on the numbers on to the top right of the widget.

6. This widget will contain two top-level tabs. One for Flickr and one for YouTube. On loading the page one of these two will be selected at random. The Flickr feed will take a random photo from a mash-up of our Imperial College London Flickr stream and a Flickr search of the term 'Imperial College London'. This tab will also have a link to our Flickr stream. The YouTube tab will pick a random video from out Imperial College London Student's Life YouTube stream and Imperial College London's Student Life YouTube favourited videos. The tab will contain a link to Imperial College London's Student Life page in YouTube. Both tabs will display the media inline and will also contain a link to an internal page which details how to get your media displayed in this widget under the link "How do I get my picture/video here?".

7. A slightly redesigned version of our current 3 homepage news stories. We will again be able to give higher prominence to news stories we wish.

8. This widget will display in succession the next 4 Union events. This will not include Club & Society events. The widget will scroll through each event every 7 seconds displaying the associated information on the event to the left. Underneath this information will be a link to 'More info' and, if the product has an associated shop product, a link to the shop. The user can select an event manually by clicking on the date on the calendar. The user can change the month using the back and forward button. If there is more than one event on the same day then there will be back and forward buttons displayed beneath the event information.

9. The My Union widget will contain a large amount of information about all areas of the Union. It would give us the chance to highlight areas of the site that you may not know about as well as bringing in information and news from external websites. Each tab can contain upto three further sub navigation tabs which will have a picture and caption. The content of the My Union widget will change if the user is logged in. The widget will have the ability to add, edit and remove RSS feeds as separate tabs. We are yet to finalise if this widget will slideshow through all the information in it, start on a random tab or be entirely manually controlled.



Clubs & Societies Landing Page

1. New breadcrumb to help aid navigation. Each page in the site will now have a persistent breadcrumb derived from it's position in the backend file structure. Before pages could inherit other sections' sub-navigation, now it will own its own at all times.

2. New vertical sub-navigation bar. Again persistent and can contain one further section of sub-navigation that will appear in an expanded list below the section you are currently in.

3. Quick Links will appear in this left hand column although will be named 'See Also' - specified by the editor of the page using the backend.

4. Same functionality of the marquee widget on the home page but a different size and content.

5. This widget will look at all the active memberships available on the website and display them in a drop-down list so users can quickly purchase memberships. The final version will not contain images but will contain the price of the membership, once selected from the drop-down, and a link to add it to their basket.

6. Same functionality as the events widget on the homepage except only showing Club & Society events, not central Union events.

7. The Clubs & Societies Latest widget will contain three tabs. News, Events & Profiles.

8. The New Products available widget will show the latest products added to the shop by Clubs & Societies. When you are logged in they will promote your Clubs & Society products first.

Section Colours

Do we want just the blue for all the site? Maybe blue for the majority of the site and then some of the other major areas such as Clubs & Societies, Events and the Information & Advice to have a different colour?






