CSB Budget

The following table outlines how much of the college subvention was awarded to CSB in the form of Union Grant (0) for the 2009/10 Budget, it also shows IC Trust funding for tours. Recent changes made by the Executive Committee include increasing the handbooks to £16,000 after a proposal from last year's DPCS, Lilly Topham.

Tours Funding & Allocation

The IC Trust no longer funds tour applications directly. Instead it has awarded the sum of £9,000 to the Union with regard to the applications it receives regarding sports tours, and the sum of £10,500 to the Union with regard to the applications it receives regarding non-sports tours, in order to avoid duplication and possible inequalities.

The tours fund stands at £28,500, to be allocated at this meeting of the Clubs and Societies Board.
