TOUR PURPOSE

This tour will allow both beginners and experienced club members to experience styles of climbing that are not possible in the UK. The aims of the tour will be to complete a number of single and large multi-pitch sport climbs and to introduce and teach newer members the techniques involved in sport climbing. The lengths of climbs that can be attempted in this location are increased. Thus we aim to give less experienced members a chance to practice the multi-pitch techniques which are essential for the development of more serious mountaineering skills.

In European climbing venues such as Arco, bolted sport climbing is the most common style of climbing. This is in contrast with the UK where the use of traditional protection is by far the most common. A sport style of climbing allows one to push the physical limits of climbing in ease and safety. The type of rock is also not one that is available for climbing in the UK. Arco is particularly suited to this type of trip since it has a large number of climbs which cover a broad range of difficulties, styles and lengths. The high density of climbing means that travelling is kept to a minimum and the weather is also ideal for climbing at a time when in the UK the weather is largely unsuitable.
