RCC Request for More Contingency

Yes, once again the RCC has run out of contingency money- apparently this is historically reoccurring, but not frequent enough for it to be worth us asking for more. On the 13th of May the RCC approved a contingency claim to the value of: £685.20

We have £284.05 left in the RCC contingency fund.

This leaves a deficit of £401.15

Can we have an extra £401.15 please?

I would argue that this has been a year of particularly expensive contingency claims-we have had further vandalism to the snooker room at the beginning of the year and this claim is due to essential equipment failing 5 years before its planned replacement date. I would also like to bring the committee's attention to the fact that the Underwater Club are funding half of the repairs from their SGI, however are not able to afford the remainder due to further planned essential expenditure.
