NOTED:

NOTED:

- a) The GSA Executive Committee are meeting next week and will discuss the GSA Standing

MAY 09 MANAGEMENT ACCOUNTS 4.

RECEIVED: The paper was presented by the Deputy President (Finance & Services)

NOTED:

a) A training session on how to read the management accounts will be organised for all Executive Committee members.

i. DH is to organise this with the Finance Manager and report back to the committee when this will be taking place.

ACTION:

- 1. DH to organise training on reading the Union Management Accounts.
- b) It was recognised that the contribution to central overheads is confusing and distorting to the accounts.
 - i. RP stated that the formula for distribution of central overheads is extraordinary.
 - Central overheads have been reduced from all centres last year which makes year on year comparison extremely difficult.
 - iii. The July accounts will have all central overheads included.
 - iv. It was suggested that this is something for the Executive Committee to consider in regards to the proportioning of central overheads. DH to talk to the Finance Manager about this.

ACTION:

- 2. DH to discuss the proportioning of central overheads with the Finance Manager.
- c) The committee moved to a vote to accept the accounts and they were passed unanimously.

5. IMPERIAL COLLEGE UNION BUDGET 2009-10

RECEIVED: The paper was presented by the President

NOTED:

- a) The budget is conservative with trading figures to acknowledge that the Eastside bar opening and improvement of the MDH will affect the Unions trading.
- b) The budget now includes everything; Clubs and Societies are not separate.
- c) The handbook budget was originally £21k but has been dropped to £16k.
 - i. It was suggested that a Welfare guide and an Academic Rep handbook were also wanted to be produced which would come under this budget. It was thought that this would be done non professional and cost would be minimal.
 - ii. The Club Officers handbook would be printed in January and would have year specific information taken out so that this could be used year on year.
 - iii. Feedback from Club Officers is that the information online is very helpful but it was also good to have a hard copy reference.
 - iv. £11k for the Freshers Handbook is a given cost.
 - v. Sponsorship for the Handbooks need to start being sought in March/April to try to get in companies budgets.
 - vi. The proposal is to add £3k to the budget for the handbook taking the total to £19k. The committee moved to a vote on increasing this amount and it was accepted unanimously.

RESOLVED:

1) To increase the amount budgeted to Handbooks to £19k.

ACTION:

1. DH to inform the Finance Manager and Student Services Manager of this change to the budget.
