Imperial College Union Court Appointments A paper by the President

Background

The ICU Court is composed of three groups of people:

- Three life members, nominated by the Executive and approved by the Council
- Three full members, nominated by the Executive and approved by the Council
- Three full members, one from each Faculty, elected by the Council

The three life members serve terms of three years, which expire in consecutive years. The life members are currently Alex Grisman (expires 2012), Hamish Common (expires 2011) and Rob Park (expires 2010).

The terms for the full members expire on the 31st July every year, however nominated members may be re-appointed without the Executive having to consider them again.

However, we have a number of vacancies.

Appointment of a new Life Member

Rob Park's term as a life member comes to an end this year. I am asking the Executive Committee to nominate Stephen Brown as his replacement. Rob is not seeking reappointment and has expressed support for Stephen's nomination.

Stephen was ICU President in 2007-2008 and now works at Deloitte.

Appointment of a new Full Member

Elly Jay and Alex Guite are not seeking re-appointment. I am asking the Executive Committee to nominate Mark Chamberlain and Karl Bonney for their places.

Mark is this year's Council Chair, was previously the ICSMSU President and will be entering his sixth and final year of Medicine next year.

Karl is a previous Media Group Chair and is currently undertaking a PhD in Chemistry.

Re-appointment of Nominated Members

The Executive Committee has previously nominated Jarlath Molloy to the Court. Council will be invited to re-appoint him. I am asking Executive Committee to endorse this course of action, although it is not necessary for the committee to renominate.

Decisions Required:

- 1. To nominate Stephen Brown as a new life member of the Court, his term to run from 1st August 2010 to 31st July 2013.
- 2. To nominate Mark Chamberlain and Karl Bonney to the Court, their terms to run from $1^{\rm st}$ August 2010 to $31^{\rm st}$ July 2011.
- 3. To endorse the re-appointment of Jarlath Molloy to the Court.
