Imperial College Union Lapsed Policies A note by the President

The final Council of the 2008-2009 session considered a number of policies which had expired. Some elements had become irrelevant in the three years since they were originally passed, however I expressed an opinion that they were worth modifying and re-passing. Rather than doing this in the meeting, Council mandated me to bring them back to the first Council of 2009-2010.

The current state of these policies is as follows:

Access to Rivers Campaign – Over the summer I contacted Mark Flower, the original proposer in 2006, who indicated that this was still an issue for the Canoe Club. The new Canoe Club committee have expressed an interest in bringing a replacement paper to Council, so it is not re-presented here.

Prayer Area Motion – This has been revised by Salman Waqar, in consultation with the Islamic Society and me. The paper has been brought to this meeting by the Equal Opportunities Officer.

Preservation of the Queen's Lawn – I have submitted a paper to this meeting, containing a revised and more generic version of the original policy.
