#### **Clubs and Societies**

- The Club Budgeting process has now started. The online budget submission system opened on 11/01/2010. It remains open till midday on the 8<sup>th</sup> February. Please tell your clubs to try out the system sooner rather than later. - The DPCS and I ran a quick tutorial on budgeting for CSC and FU Chairs and Treasurers. Hopefully they will be able to answer any questions clubs throw at them.
- Tour applications: A lot of clubs have been sending spring tour applications in. The deadline was yesterday. I will be reviewing each budget this week.
- Last week at Exec minibus charges were set for next year. You will be pleased to hear due to the Vans cost centre performing well above budget; we have decided not to raise hire charges.
- Also at Exec last week a new funding model for FU's was proposed by the President. The new
  model will involve FU's bidding for money from RWB and CSB. I'm sure this will involve a lot of
  number crunching for me over the next month and hopefully, it won't be too much of a logistical
  nightmare.

### **Commercial Services & Entertainments**

- The Christmas Ball was a huge success with over 900 students packing out dB's, da Vinci's and the Union Bar. Feedback from the night has been very positive.

- The Catering promotions from last term were well received however sales on deals were not as high as expected. Further evening catering deals will be introduced in February.

- Work on the summer ball is progressing well. We are currently discussing logistics for the night and possible headline acts.
- The dinner will be held in the Tower Rooms and will be followed by a comedian for after dinner entertainment.
- I have many meetings planned over the next two weeks to talk to people in college about the ball.
