Union Honorary Senior Treasurer
A Note by the President

The Union Honorary Senior Treasurer authorises all payments above £1000 by the Union. They are an observer of The Executive Committee and the Trustee Board and so play an important role as an independent source of advice and guidance.

Dr Simon Archer is currently the Union Honorary Senior Treasurer, however from 1 August he will move onto a two-day-per-week role in College as a College Tutor. He has said that two days per week is not enough to carry on the role as Union Honorary Senior Treasurer and so began the search for a replacement.

A new Honorary Senior Treasurer 'shall be determined by the Trustee Board on the advice of the Executive Committee and approved by the Rector or his or her nominee'.

Exec Resolves: To advise the Trustee Board to appoint Dr Lorraine Craig as Union Honorary Senior Treasurer, for subsequent approval by the Rector, to begin office on 1 August 2011.

N.B. The changes the DPFS is bringing to the Constitution (discussed at the next Council) will lead to there being several (3-4) Union Honorary Senior Treasurers as the Management Group Honorary Senior Treasurers are being made redundant. Several more candidates will be found to fill these roles but I suggest having a direct replacement for Dr Archer is a good idea as they can have a hand-over and Dr Craig can assume the role of 'Head' Union Honorary Senior Treasurer.
