Felix Advertisements
A Paper by ICU President – Scott Heath

Background

1. Agenda Item 7 of the 24 November 2011 Meeting was a paper presented by the Felix Editor (10-11) discussing the advertisements the Union took in Felix for 2009-10.
2. It was requested that the Union Executive allow Felix to receive payment for the 34 adverts it took in this period, totalling £5,610.
3. Felix's finances are currently:
 - a. Grant (0) : +£2,942.86
 - b. SGI (1): -£2,719.63
 - £223.23
4. It was decided at the November meeting that the decision would roll over to the end of the year in order to see how the Union's finances are.
5. The Executive have multiple options available. Such options are:
 - a. To give Felix the £5,610 it requests;
 - b. To give a different sum to Felix for their advertisements – reflecting the lag in invoicing time;
 - c. Stall the decision to the next financial year;
 - d. To reject the request from Felix.

Resolves

1. The Executive Committee resolves to choose a resolution from 5a – 5d.
