

Allocation of RWB money

Background

Under the old constitution, there was a body known as the Representation and Welfare board. This board consisted of the Deputy President (Welfare) and the Deputy President (Education). Since the passing of the new constitution, this board has been split into the Education and Representation Board and the Community and Welfare Board. However there is a pot of money that was assigned to RWB in the previous years budgeting, this paper discusses the splitting of the budget.

Proposals
