**NCC**

Two new clubs, the Economics society and the Design Collective have successfully passed through the new NCC process the New Club Incubator. They both ran zero cost events which were well attended and received. There is still one club in the New Club Incubator Hillsong Connect.

When the New Club Incubator was approved as a process in CSB the question of funding for club events was raised. I think this is something which I will look into as the next set of clubs pass through the system. I can see the potential use for funding available for events however one of the goals of the NCI is to encourage and show clubs that they can run a successful event without spending much money. If any funding is made available to groups in the NCI should not undermine these ideas.

**Storage Space**

A new storage room is being made available for club storage. This room is on level 1 on the west side of the building. The room has now been cleared and application forms have been received from clubs requesting space. These will be allocated as we can as some more shelving is still needed.
