Associate Membership Policy

A Proposed Trustee Board Policy

- 1. Associate Membership of the Union as defined in the constitution is reserved for persons under the following conditions:
- 1.1. A College or Union member of staff, upon receipt of a monthly or annual subscription payment.
- 1.2. A student of any Further or Higher Education establishment, upon receipt of a monthly or annual subscription payment.
- 1.3. A previous Member of the Union upon receipt of a one off payment for lifetime Associate Membership.
- 1.4. A previous Associate Member of the Union, who has held such membership for a period of two years, upon receipt of a one off payment for lifetime Associate Membership.
- 1.5. A person that is renting or using College or Union facilities, upon receipt of a daily or weekly payment.
- 2. Associate Membership entitles the holder to make use of all the Union's facilities, amenities and services.
- 3. Associate Members are not entitled to receive any form of subsidy from the Union.
- 4. Associate Members are not entitled to participate in the governance of the Union, except as an External or Alumni Trustee.
- 5. Honorary lifetime Associate Membership may be bestowed upon an individual by the Union Council, irrespective of their membership status of the Union.
- 6. Only lifetime Associate Members are eligible for lifetime membership of any constituent part of the Union.
- 7. Associate Membership may be removed from an individual by a simple majority vote of the Trustee Board or the Union Council.
