Introduction

The New Clubs Committee was formed to decide whether proposed clubs and societies fitted with the aims and objectives of the Union and was there to assess the sustainability of the club.

The New Clubs Committee has 3 members: all taken from the Clubs, Societies & Projects Board. One member must be from the Constituent Unions, one member must be from the Management Group Chairs. The meetings occur three times a term and the committee is also allocated a budget from the CSPB contingency as start-up grants for the new clubs.

Decisions required:

- 1. Elect 1 Faculty Union Reps to the New Clubs Committee
- 2. Elect 1 CSC Chairs to the New Clubs Committee
- 3. Elect 1 other to the New Clubs Committee
- 4. Elect 1 reserve for the New Clubs Committee
