Corsica has a stunning alpine landscape with peaks over 2,000m that dramatically fall away into the sea. This landscape means there is an abundance of beautiful bolted rock to climb, from coarse weathered granite rock, to sandstone or limestone rock. There is climbing all over the island, from single pitch routes to multi-pitch routes up to 600m long, plus many bouldering areas. In fact, Corsica claims to have more unclimbed rock than anywhere else in Europe!

The purpose of the tour will be to give members of the club, new and old, an experience of climbing in a mountainous area at whatever level is best suited to them. In particular, this is a fantastic introduction to multi-pitch climbing in a beautiful setting.

We will fly to Campo dell Oro Airport in Ajaccio and hire vehicles to get to our accommodation in Corti.
