Goals

Governance & Democracy review

- The Constitution & Bye-Laws have been re-circulated for Council to vote.
- As part of the longer term Governance Plan, Governance Committee and Board are reviewing the remit of 'governance' and providing a clearer forward agenda. This should aid the committee in shaping discussions and ensuring timely review of policies.

Development of key volunteers

- I hope that the new subcommittees of Council will continue to improve the dialogue between staff, Officer Trustees and senior volunteers.
- We are continuing to work on improved training for incoming volunteers.

Wellbeing Strategy

Operations

Union Budgeting

- The Union budgeting process is almost complete. The budget for next year will be presented to Finance & Risk Committee on 19 June and Board of Trustees on 28 June. Matt and I heard presentations from all budget holders and the budgeting panel have been working with staff to produce the final budget for presentation to Board.

Union Awards

- Union awards planning has been ongoing with the event on 15 June. Thank you to all those who participated on award panels.

Student Trustees

- Shortlisted candidates are being interviewed on 13 June. The panel comprises myself, Fintan, Jill Finney (Chair of Board) and Jarlath O'Hara (Managing Director). We had 9 very strong applications submitted.
