Introduction

Nominations for Autumn Elections usually open on the first day of term each academic year. This allows just enough time to elect Reps (primarily Academic Reps, Wellbeing Reps and Reps to Council) before Student Staff Committees and Union Council meet for the first time towards the end of October.

However, this poses a challenge to participation since new students are often not acquainted with our complex representation structures before they are asked to stand for positions. It also doesn't allow much time to prime returning students who are bombarded with lots of information at the start of each term.

Last year, this was combatted through the provision of more information during the Welcome process. That meant the concept of electing reps was introduced during the digital channels for A Level Results Day in August and was reinforced further in other communications before arrival such as email and at Union stalls and events such as fair during the Welcome period.

This helped increase engagement among first year students and helped contributed to the robust turnout seen in the last election.

This year, the Elections Working Group proposes to go one step further in attempting to offset this challenge by pushing the polls back by one week. This would still allow time for SSC meetings and would allow all reps to be in place before the second proposed Union Council meeting on 5 November as is customary.
