- Total of £8,893.43 in GSU's account
 - o Awarded £3,500 from union for the 19/20 academic year
 - £2,861.31 for publicity
 - 638.69 for ground hire
 - £9,835.24 from college carried over from last year
 - o £4,441.81 removed due to SGI
- More funds required to achieve goals and run a GSU winter ball

4. Representation:

a. PRES:

- Worked on PRES results and Union feedback report with Ashley Brooks
- Recommend several actions for both the Union and College
- Report was discussed at PRQC in October and a working group is to be set-up to address the actions
- Most issues relate to supervision and well-being
 - To address this, we have recommended that a graduate community hub is created

5. Operations:
