## **Updates**:

- B.A.U priorities are refunds, DPFS objectives, CSP support and contracts
- Summer Ball
  - The go/no-go date is officially May 18<sup>th</sup>, at which point comms will be prepared and an update for students with tickets sent out
  - Looking ahead, the Summer Ball Committee will continue but will change in structure, putting a greater focus on creative control and removing operational responsibility. This will enable students to shape the Summer Ball, and for the DPFS & the Union to deliver that vision effectively.
- Welcome 2020
  - Considering different scenarios of what Imperial may look like by October 2020, and what potential guidelines/restrictions may affect how we welcome incoming students.
  - Greater focus on working with students in delivering appropriate and engaging events throughout Welcome Week, and improving inclusivity.
- DPFS Objectives for the next 3 months:

  - High Risk Event Management and Debt Management for CSPs
  - Finance Training Review
  - Summer Ball/Major Events Process
  - Handover
- Block Grant bid has been submitted and is with College, who are currently in their budgeting round
- Staffing at the Union:
  - Sat on the interview panel for, and appointed, the new Finance Director at the Union
  - o Events & Conferences Manager started in April
  - Empty roles paused upon lockdown
