# Improving the accountability of Officer Trustees' through scrutiny of their manifesto promises

### **Union notes:**

- 1. In their manifestos, individuals running for Officer Trustee (OT) positions may make promises of actions they will take if elected.
- 2. Within the Standing Orders of Union Council, there is no requirement for OTs to share their progress on these promises in their Council reports.

#### **Union believes:**

- 1. One of the primary functions of Council is to scrutinize the OTs' performance and to hold them to account.
- 2. Manifesto promises that are unfulfilled without justification or omitted from reports may erode confidence in the OTs, and our student democracy.

#### **Union resolves:**

- 1. Amend Appendix A of the Council Standing Orders to require that all OTs include a section regarding manifesto promises in their **first Council report**. This should include **all** main manifesto points, why there are/are not being pursued, and how they can be achieved (Appendix A).
- 2. OT manifestos will be shared with Council prior to the first Council meeting, to ensure that the reports can be cross-examined against the manifestos.
- 3. Council may at any point in the year request an update on the status of manifesto promises, to be featured within next OT report.

## Appendix A: Proposed wording of amendment

"The first report of each year must contain a section regarding manifesto promises. This should include all main points featured in the manifesto, why there are/are not being pursued, and how they can be achieved."
