Motion to approve changes to halls policies

Union notes

- 1. For first year undergraduates Halls of Residence, there is a £2.50 per student per week contribution to a Social Fund that funds the core social calendar for the year.
- 2. The Union currently provides support in terms of financial administration of the Halls Social Fund.
- 3. There currently exists a 'Halls Social Fund policy' that has not been updated in several years.
- 4. A draft of a general 'Halls Policy' that aimed to clarify the relationship with Halls outside of just the Social Fund has existed for 2 years but has not been approved.
- 5. An amended version of the 'Halls Policy' was approved at the College's Residential Life Committee meeting on 1st June 2021.

Union believes

- 6. Halls are a crucial element of the transitional experience for students so should be supported by the Union.
- 7. Students should lead their social activity programme in halls, as it is funded by a levy on their rent and is for their benefit.
- 8. As the Union administers the Halls Social Fund, it should align with the Union's financial procedures and be administered in a responsible way.

Union resolves

- 9. To approve the amended Halls Policy with amended Social Fund Policy that has undergone the following changes:
- a) General reduction of length (2450 total words to 1550)
- b) Removal of out-of-date information and improving precision/accuracy of language
- c) Removal of some impractical expectations on Halls
- d) Consolidated the two policies into one general 'Halls Policy' that has the 'Social Fund Policy' as an appendix
